READIN' – 'RITIN' – REELIN'
TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All persons in boat must be entered in tournament and are required to sign entry form on Friday evening. LIMIT 6 PERSONS PER BOAT. Max of 4 persons aged 16 or over.
2. All Federal, State, and tournament rules will be abided by, including a valid fishing license. NO OVERSIZED TAGGED REDFISH ALLOWED.
3. No one with a U.S. Coast Guard Captain's License that has guided professionally in the last 5 years may fish in this tournament.
4. The fishing area will be restricted to the following areas: Matagorda Bay and east to Cotton's Bayou, Tres Palacios Bay, Espiritu Santos Bay, San Antonio Bay, Mission Bay, Hines Bay, Lavaca Bay, Keller Bay, Carancahua Bay, and the intercoastal waterway to the south side of San Antonio Bay.
5. All fish must be caught by pole or rod & reel in adherence to State Law.
6. All fish entered into the tournament become property of the tournament.
7. All fish submitted for weigh-in must be in fresh edible condition. Frozen, thawed, spoiled, pale, gilled or altered (tall shaving) fish not in its natural state will be disqualified.
8. In the event of a tie for weight, length will determine the winner.
9. In keeping with the philosophy of the conservation of the fishery, only one trout 25 inches or more will be allowed at weigh-in, per team.
- 10. No swapping of fish after team member is in line for weigh-in. Teams not in line by 5:00 will not be eligible.**
11. Any team violating State or Federal law will be disqualified in the category in which the violation occurred.
12. Winners are subject to a polygraph test to insure the validity of their catch during the tournament.
13. ALL decisions of Tournament Officials are final.
NO APPEALS. Any violations of above rules will lead to immediate disqualification.

K of C #9088 reserves the right to
refuse entry to tournament at will.
